In 2017 an application was submitted to The Environment Agency to vary permit ADA5710 to allow further excavation of the Riparian Ditch beyond the existing hard bed. There were certain conditions associated with The Environment Agency approving the variation to the consent. As no work requiring digging beyond the existing hard bed has happened over the past 6 years the Environment Agency must now close this variation.
