Crimes and incidents

Wiltshire Police record crimes and incidents by the National Crime and incident recording standards. Not all incidents that one would consider a crime are necessarily classified as a crime for recording purposes.

NB- The statistics do not account for incidents that police respond to but do not need any follow up (Road traffic incidents, minor incidents of Anti-social behaviour)

A sample of Crimes & Occurrences in the month of August 2024 are shown below:

Motoring related offences

In August in Wilton, Speed enforcement caught 20 vehicles speeding on the 1st, 30 Vehicles on the 12th on the Avenue & 3 Vehicles on the 16th on South Street. Both locations clearly display a speed limit of 30mph. The fastest vehicles were captured at 52mph, 49mph & 41mph respectively.

Depending on previous convictions and history, 40 drivers will be offered a speed awareness course, 11 drivers will receive a fixed penalty notice and 3 points. 2 drivers will be subject to court recovery.

Proceedings will now be undertaken to ensure the most appropriate outcome for the offenders takes place.



<u>Warrants</u>

Five men have been arrested in relation to drugs offences following the execution of warrants in Wilton (16/08/2024).

Up to 40 officers from local Neighbourhood Policing Teams, the Intel Department, the Armed Response Group, and the Dogs Unit carried out the warrants on the four properties.

Ten people were initially detained during the operation which was carried out in the morning. A total of five men have now been arrested on suspicion of being concerned in the supply of Class A and C drugs and concerned in the cultivation of Class C drugs.

The arrests included one man who was wanted after being recalled to prison.

Drugs, imitation firearms, and several knives, including zombie-style knives were recovered during the searches.
