Crimes and incidents

Wiltshire Police record crimes and incidents by the National Crime and incident recording standards. Not all incidents that one would consider a crime are necessarily classified as a crime for recording purposes.

NB- The statistics do not account for incidents that police respond to but do not need any follow up (Road traffic incidents, minor incidents of Anti-social behaviour)

<u>A sample of Crimes & Occurrences in the month of September 2024 are shown below:</u>

Motoring related offences

Speed Enforcement caught 9 vehicles speeding on 10 September 2024 in Wilton on The Avenue. Although this looks like a significant reduction in speeding behaviour at this site, long grass waving in the wind was presenting an obstruction to the officer's line of sight and enforcement was necessarily curtailed.

This stretch of road has a clearly displayed speed limit of **30mph**. The fastest vehicles were captured travelling at **41mph**. On the day in question, it was overcast but dry. Depending on previous convictions and history: -

7 drivers will be offered a speed awareness course.

2 drivers will receive a Fixed Penalty Notice and 3 points.

Proceedings will now be undertaken to ensure the most appropriate outcome for the offenders takes place.

<u>Warrants</u>

Following the execution of warrants in Wilton (16/08/2024), Wiltshire Council Housing Department issued eviction notices on 20/09/2024 to the tenants/occupants of all four addresses. They have been given 1 months to vacate the premises.

Criminal Damage /ASB

Following work with our colleagues at Wiltshire Council Housing Department, the problematic individual at Churchill Court has now been evicted from the premises and is no longer residing in the area.
