# Mayor Making Procedure Policy

Procedural notes for the Mayor's Ceremony of the Wilton Town Council, to be held in the Council Chamber, Kingsbury Square, Wilton, on Tuesday .... May 202.. at 7.00pm.

Wilton Town Council will nominate and elect the Mayor and Deputy Mayor at the Annual Meeting of Wilton Town Council to be held on the first Tuesday in May or, in an election year, within 14 days of Councillors taking office following an election.

The Mayor and Deputy Mayor will sign their Declaration of Acceptance of Office at the Annual Meeting of Wilton Town Council.

The vote of thanks to the Mayor stepping down at the Annual Meeting of Wilton Town Council will be given that meeting, by the Councillor nominating the Mayor the previous year.

The Mayor Making Ceremony will take place on the Tuesday following the Annual Meeting of Wilton Town Council.

6.45 for 6.55pm

1. Councillors, Town Clerk and Mace Bearer to meet in the Mayor's Parlour, to gown up.

Councillors to take seats around the large central Council Table in the Wilton Town Council Chamber, except the newly elected Mayor and Deputy Mayor.

6.55pm

2. The Wilton Town Clerk will call on the assembled guests and members of the public in the Council Chamber to stand.

7.00pm

**3. Their Worship the Mayor**, will process into the Council Chamber, preceded by the **Mace Bearer**, and accompanied by the **Town Clerk**.

Followed by the **Deputy Mayor** 

The Mace Bearer will turn to the right at the bottom end of the central Council Table, and process towards the Mayoral Dais passing the right hand side of the central Council Table, place the Mace on the top 'Mace' Table, and take up their position standing at the right hand side of the Mace Table.

The **Mayor** will **keep to the left** at the **bottom end** of the central Council table, and process **onto the Mayoral Dais**, passing the left hand side of the central Council Table

The **Town Clerk** will follow the Mace Bearer to take their place **on The Mayoral Dais**, and stand to the Mayor's left.

The **Deputy Mayor** will keep to the left at the bottom end of the central Council table, and process onto the Mayoral Dais, passing the left hand side of the central Council Table to take their place **on The Mayoral Dais**, and stand to the **Mayor's** right.

Their Worship The Mayor will stand before the Mayoral Chair.

The **Town Clerk** will stand to the **Mayor's** left.

The **Deputy Mayor** will stand to the **Mayor's** right.

- **4.** The **Mayor** will declare the **Mayor Making** open.
- 5. The Town Clerk will request the Councillors, invited guests and members of the public to sit.
- 6. The Mayor will give an address.
- 7. The Mayor will give an Address of Acceptance of Office.
- **8.** The **Mayor** will invest their **Consort**, or announce other arrangements.
- 9. The Mayor will introduce the Deputy Mayor.
- 10. The Deputy Mayor will give an Address of Acceptance of Office.
- 11. The Mayor will appoint their Chaplain, if wished.
- **12.** The **Chaplain**, if appointed, will respond.

## **END OF THE MAYOR MAKING CEREMONY**

At the conclusion of the Annual Meeting of Wilton Town Council Meeting, the **Mace Bearer** will form up at the head of the central Council Table, and escort the **Mayor**, **Town Clerk and Deputy Mayor** from the Council Chamber. The Councillors will follow and process from the Council Chamber into the Mayor's Parlour, with the Senior Councillors leading the way.

The Mayor will host a Wilton Town Council Reception for invited guests.
