A Policy to regulate the use of a Wilton Town Trailer to Support Wilton Community Resilience.

Legal context

This Policy aims to ensure that Wilton Town Council defines the conditions of use for a trailer.

The purpose of this policy

This Policy is to control the management and operation of a trailer purchased with a SSEN grant to support Wilton Town Council Community

1. Introduction

This Policy is to control the management, operation and use of a single axle trailer acquired by Wilton Town Council through a grant from the Scottish and Southern Electricity Networks Resilient Communities Fund.

2. Statement of Purpose

The primary use of this trailer will be to transport the Crow Lane Flood Barrier modules for deployment and for return after dismantling.

3. Insurance:

Whilst in storage the Trailer will be Insured as an Asset of Wilton Town Council

Whilst in use the Trailer will need to be Insured by the Towing Vehicle Policy.

It is imperative that any Volunteer using their own vehicle to tow the trailer has checked that;

- (i) Their insurance policy has cover for a trailer.
- (ii) Their Driving License entitles them to tow a trailer.
