Crimes and incidents

Wiltshire Police record crimes and incidents by the National Crime and incident recording standards. Not all incidents that one would consider a crime are necessarily classified as a crime for recording purposes.

NB- The statistics do not account for incidents that police respond to but do not need any follow up (Road traffic incidents, minor incidents of Anti-social behaviour)

Motoring Related Offences

Speed Enforcement caught **12** vehicles speeding on **24 March 2025** in **Wilton at two sites: - South Street, plus a short session on The Avenue.**

Both stretches of road have clearly displayed speed limits of **30mph**. The fastest vehicles were captured travelling at **43mph on The Avenue**. The fastest vehicle on **South Street was travelling at 42mph**. On the day in question, it was sunny and roads were dry.

Depending on previous convictions and history: -

10 drivers will be offered a speed awareness course
2 drivers will receive a Fixed Penalty Notice and 3 points.
