## FC268 To consider candidates for co-option on to Wilton Town Council

Officer report 0226FC04 was received.

Proposed by Cllr Edge and seconded by Cllr Matthews it was **RESOLVED** to co-opt Cllr Gary Blandford-Hull to Wilton Town Council. Cllr Blandford-Hull joined the meeting after signing the Declaration of Acceptance of Office.

Cllr Blackman abstained from the vote.

## FC269 To receive various reports for information to Full Council

Officer report 0226FC05 was received and NOTED.

**Civic Report** – Cllr Harrison, Mayor provided an update on the Annual 799<sup>th</sup> Salisbury Charter Sunday event and referred to the Wilts [TV interview](#) where he explains the council priorities and community focus.

Cllr Harrison spoke to Councillors at the charter event about the Fire Station consultation and the need to have further collaborative conversations about Wilton representation.

**Cllr Pauline Church** provided a Wiltshire Council update:

- Wilton Fire Station – DWFRS – 8 Fire Stations – Wilton included in consultation. Wilton is one of the lowest funded services in the UK. Against the closure and leaves our town more vulnerable.
- Flooding – Water Ditchampton road opened on Friday by Wiltshire Council highways. As water levels are not receding, drivers are encouraged to drive slowly. Meeting with all stakeholders to drive proactive communications with residents is being arranged.
- Wiltshire Council budget – Cllr Church is a member of the Finance Select Committee – she advised residents and councillors to attend the Budget meeting on 24 February 2026.
- Cllr Church will make contact with Cllr Kevin Daley (Great Wishford) to raise concerns with potholes and the poor state of the road between Water Ditchampton and Great Wishford village.
- Request was made to erect a footbridge to aid pedestrians during floods – the member of the public was encouraged to refer the family to Cllr Church.

**Wiltshire Police** provided a [report](#) to cover January related activity - the chair read out the report.

- 26 vehicles caught speeding on 4 February 2026

- 22 drivers will be offered speed awareness courses
- 3 drivers will receive a Fixed Penalty Notice and 3 points
- 1 driver will be subject to court recovery
- Advice given to report flooding related incidents to Highways at Wiltshire Council – do not remove the signs and cones – it is Highways responsibility to assess road closures.

Proposed by Cllr Boyd and seconded by Cllr Edge it was further **RESOLVED** to appoint on Scale Point LC2 range 29 - 32.

Proposed by Cllr Ditton and seconded by Cllr Alexander it was further **RESOLVED** to pay the rate of pay as per the existing temporary contract subject to an annual review and satisfactory performance.

Proposed by Cllr Ditton and seconded by Cllr Alexander it was further **RESOLVED** that the Town Clerk/ Responsible Finance Officer is a nominated Bank Signatory on the WTC bank accounts.
